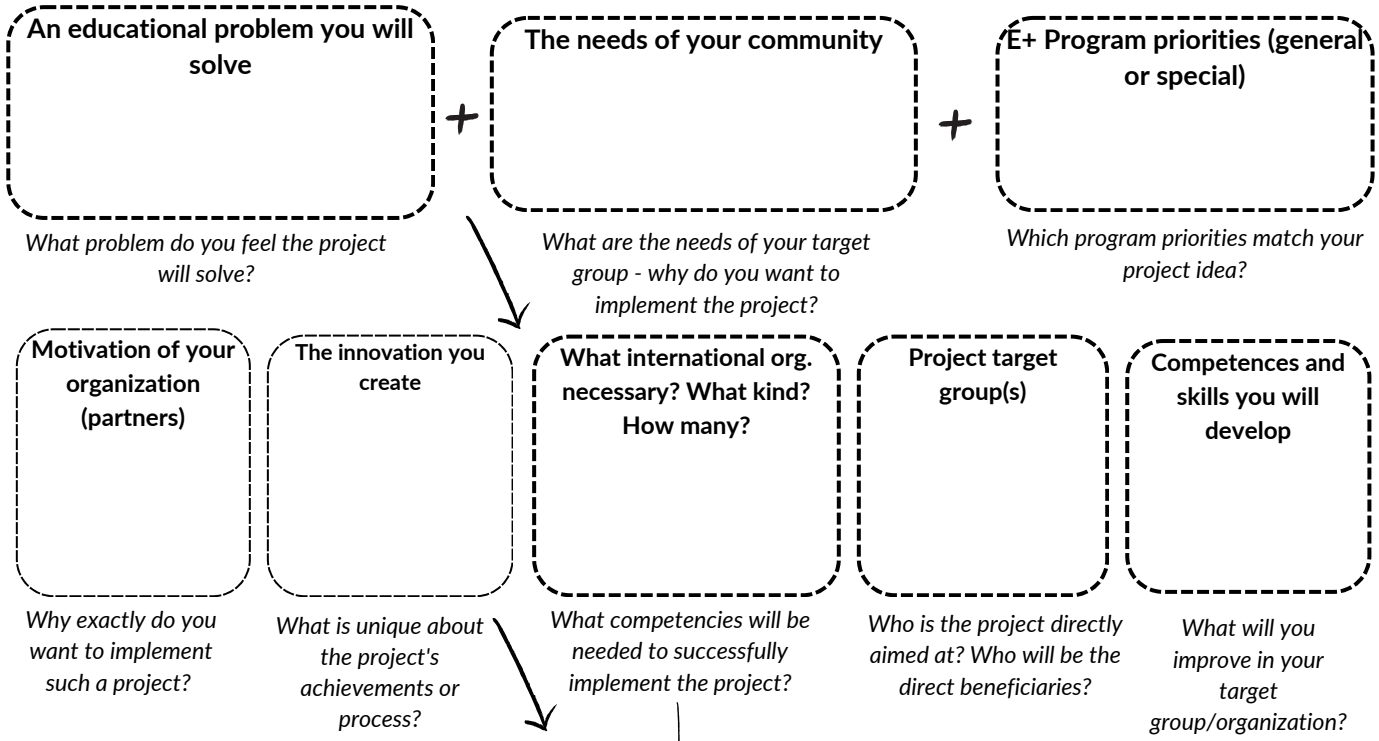


Name of the project:

The name of the project must be short, attractive, but also reflect the main idea of the project

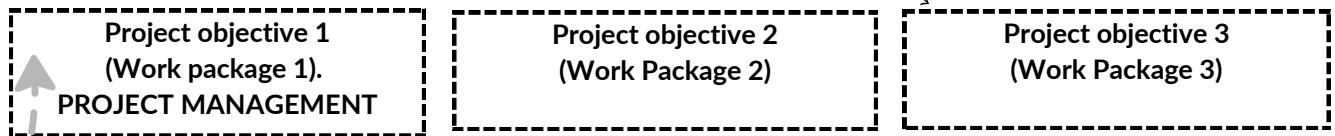


How will you act equally, resolve conflicts, communicate, archive results

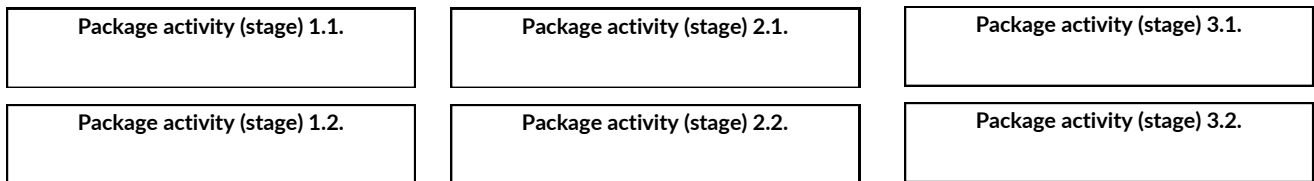
Management, team and communication with partners, project sustainability

The aim of the project:

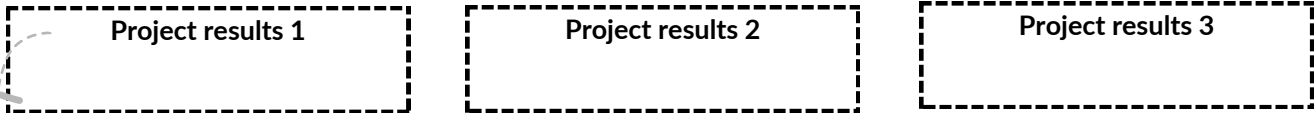
Clear, including the overall goal of the entire project (not one specific activity). It can reflect the ambition to solve a problem of your choice, achieve impact, introduce innovation



A work package is a group of activities aimed at one common specific goal that meets the following aspects: 1) has one common specific goal; 2) includes various types of activities to achieve that specific goal; 3) after implementing activities, tangible/intangible results measured by appropriate qualitative/quantitative indicators are achieved; 4) milestones.



Activity - a specific action, stage (meeting, training, product, process, etc.) which, if implemented, will bring you closer to the fulfillment of the package.

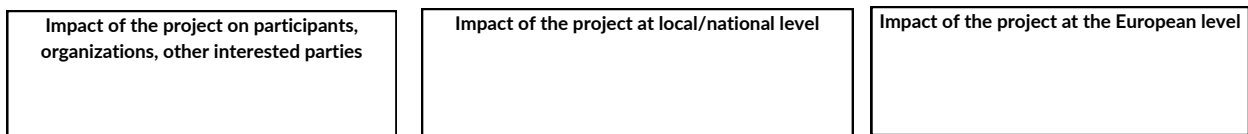


The result is your achievement after the implementation of activities and tasks. It can be tangible (a book, a program, etc.) or it can be intangible (new skills, changes, networks created, etc.).

It is important to spread the word about what you have achieved and if it is useful to wider groups than just the project participants. What specifically and to whom, when and in what format you will deliver/send/distribute/transmit etc.
